Frequently Asked Questions

What is the local youth advisory board?

The Souper Bowl of Caring Local Youth Advisory Board is a group of outstanding youth from across North Texas charged with leading their generation to help transform Super Bowl weekend into the nation's largest youth-led weekend of giving and serving. Members of the LYAB are given opportunities to have their voices heard and make a positive and dramatic impact in their communities.

LYAB members provide the Souper Bowl of Caring with a body of knowledge and perspective to assist the organization in understanding and working with youth.

Finally, the LYAB serves as the face of the Souper Bowl of Caring's youth-led movement to the media, acting as a source for quotes, speeches, and stories about the organization and their experiences with it.

What responsibilities do LYAB members have?

Members of the LYAB must attend one orientation/meeting organized by Souper Bowl of Caring in Fort Worth, TX. This meeting is scheduled for Saturday, December 14th, 2013 from 10am to 2pm.
